

## A JOURNEY IN TIME AND SPACE TO AN EARLIER MILLENNIUM

Philip 2 of Macedonia as an important urban and cultural center of the ancient magistral road *Via Ignatia*, which stretched from the Adriatic to the Aegean sea.

Ohrid, renowned for its churches, received the epithet „the Balkan Jerusalem,, , a

holy city under the protection of eternity and immortality.

Through St.Clement, the first Slav Episcop and patron saint of Ohrid, the city became the center of the Ohrid Archiepiscop, and location of the first all

Slav University in Europe. Later, it was to gain distinction as capital city of the first Macedonian - Slav state - the Kingdom of Tzar Samoil.

Among its most famous cultural/historical monuments are: the Fortress of Samoil, a theatre from antiquity, early Christian basilicas, sacred monuments of the Middle Ages, collections of icons, and old style architecture. The living embodiment of its history, Ohrid is the cultural, spiritual, and tourist center of Macedonia. The magnificence of its splendors, and the beauty of its natural surroundings, have combined to make Ohrid, a city for all the world, under the protection of UNESCO.

Situated on a „magic hill,, which rises above the northern coast of beautiful Lake Ohridsko, the history of Ohrid reaches more than 2,400 years into the past. Known in earlier times as Lihnid, the city of Ohrid first receives mention in connection with King
